

Guidelines for Monday/Wednesday Food Disbursal Participation

- All participants must be income eligible and registered by Rosemary or Zac
- This program is not related to or contingent upon Center membership
- All participants who are not registered must wait until after all registered participants have been called
- All participants must be present, with their name in the box, by or before 10am
- Participants who arrive after 10am must wait for all others to be called before they may collect
- When name drawing begins, at 10am, all participants must be at the tables
→ **If a participant name is drawn and they are not at the designated tables, their name will not be called, and they will be placed back in the box**
- Each participant must bring their own bags (there may not always be extra bags available if forgotten)
- 1 bag is to be used for bread, cakes, desserts, etc.
- 1 bag is to be used for produce and other food items that may be available
- Participation is per household, not per individual, regardless of the number of people in your household or present from your household
- Center staff reserves the right to limit the amount of food each household takes to ensure that all participants and community members have fair access
- All participants are expected to treat one another with courtesy and respect in adherence to the values and mission of the Center
- Center staff reserves the right to suspend participants who refuse to respect these guidelines.
