- **Day One: Arrival to Victorian Cape May, New Jersey:** Cape May is a seaside resort city on the southern New Jersey Cape May Peninsula! We will arrive late evening to the Cape May Court House, and will check into our lodging for the next two evenings. There will be time to freshen up before dinner. ***Meals: Dinner***
- **Day Two: Time in Historic Cape May:** After breakfast this morning enjoy the day exploring Cape May! We’ll begin with a visit and guided tour of the Emlen Physick Estate, the magnificent Stick-Style mansion attributed to renowned Victorian architect Fran Furness. A tour of the fifteen beautifully restored rooms gives you a glimpse into the lifestyle of this Victorian-era Cape May family. After, we’ll enjoy a narrated trolley tour of Cape May’s Historic District, and see Cape May’s National Landmark District – the gingerbread houses, the oldest residential neighborhood in the city, and the elegant Grande Dames of the Victorian commercial center. At midday, we’ll spend some free time at the Washington Street Pedestrian Mall to include lunch on our own. In the afternoon we’ll visit the Marketplace at Teaberry’s, historically known as Teaberry’s Antique General Store. From there we’ll return to the resort to freshen up before dinner and a performance at the popular Elaine’s Dinner Theatre.
- **Day Three: Baltimore, Maryland & Mileage:** This morning we’ll enjoy breakfast and some free time before we check out and make our way to Baltimore! Upon our early afternoon arrival, we’ll have time to spend at the National Aquarium, home to more than twenty thousand aquatic animals. During this time on our own at the aquarium we’ll have a chance for lunch on our own. From there, we’ll head over to the Inner Harbor to enjoy more free time for sight-seeing, and then we’re off to our lodging for the evening to check in and freshen up before an outstanding buffet dinner and show at Toby’s Dinner Theatre! ***Meals: Breakfast & Dinner***
- **Day Four: Greenbrier Resort & Mileage:** Following breakfast, we head out to White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia for a spectacular couple of days at the Greenbrier Resort! After check in, we’ll have time for a tour of the famous Bunker! The declassified bunker is a must-see experience that takes you behind the scenes and walks you through a fascinating period in the resort’s history. Carved deep into the mountainside is an emergency Cold War fallout shelter! Once a top-secret government relocation facility for Congress, the Bunker is now open to anyone interested in reliving a legendary piece of Greenbrier history. Explore an aspect that no other resort can claim, including unique tours and hidden doors! After time in the Bunker, we’ll be able to freshen up before dinner in the Main Dining Room. ***Meals: Breakfast & Dinner***



- **Day Five: Afternoon Tea at the Greenbrier & Concert:** After a bountiful breakfast, enjoy time exploring the resort. Take in a hike on the trails around the resort, relax at the spa, enjoy some shopping, or just get cozy and people watch! In the afternoon we're invited to partake in a Greenbrier tradition that guests have been enjoying since the 1930s – afternoon tea and music! Sip your tea, nibble on freshly-prepared pastries and cookies, and enjoy live piano music and/or dancers in the resort's Grand Upper Lobby. We'll again dine in the Main Dining Room for dinner. ***Meals: Breakfast, Afternoon tea & snacks, Dinner***
- **Day Six: Flight 93 Memorial, Shanksville, Pennsylvania:** Following breakfast we'll depart from the gorgeous Greenbrier Resort and head to Stoystown, PA, where we plan to arrive at the Flight 93 Memorial & Visitors' Center in the early afternoon. We'll begin our visit at the Visitor Center Complex featuring an exhibit area, learning center, Allee and Western Overlook trailheads, as well as the Flight Path Walkway and Overlook. The Memorial Plaza, a quarter-mile northern boundary of the crash site, is the final resting place of the passengers and crew who thwarted a direct attack on the US Capitol on September 11, 2001. The visit culminates with a self guided visit to the Wall of Names, which features forty polished marble stones bearing the names of the passengers and flight crew. This experience includes interpretive panels that provide an overview of the story of that day and Flight 93, with cell phone & mobile tours for more in-depth exploration. Later in the afternoon we'll depart for our overnight lodging in Harrisburg, PA. ***Meals: Breakfast & Dinner***
- **Day Seven: Civil War Museum:** Following breakfast, we will depart for the Civil War Museum. The museum is the only one in the United States that portrays the entire story of the American Civil War. History here is preserved in equally balanced presentations that are humanistic in nature, and free of Union or Confederate bias. That evening we have a farewell dinner planned. ***Meals: Breakfast & Dinner***
- **Day Eight: Mohegan Sun Poconos & Home:** This morning we will have breakfast and then depart from the Harrisburg area. On our way home we'll stop at the Mohegan Sun Poconos for some free time and lunch on our own. We will arrive back home by early evening. ***Meals: Breakfast***
